NOTE: Online Internal Marks entry, Application submission and fee payment is a must through **pmb.campusuite.in**. If the college authorities fail to submit through online, it will not be considered for examination.

2. Examination Applications Fee Structure Details:

2	Examination Fee for Two Subjects	600-00
3	Examination Fee for more than two subjects, Freshers and for all subjects	1100-00
4	Late Examination fee- fine per day	15-00

3. Those candidates who wish to increase/to perform better can do so by withdrawing/surrendering the original result in each subject. The original result will stand cancelled once they appear for examination.
4. New Scheme (RS-2) candidate should score minimum 50% of IA marks (5/10) and 75% attendance must be there for eligibility to appear for examination.
5. Internal Assessment Marks of the fresh and repeater candidates in all subjects must enter online before submitting examination application is mandatory.
6. Hard copy of the IA marks report and Examination Application must be submitted to the Board on or before **18.10.2021 at 5.30 p.m** without fail.
